

Multigard Trap - ASSEMBLY & USE

Item List: Trap






The color of the trap is visually attractive to a number of pests. Therefore, no additional bait is needed.

- 2 Remove square knockouts.
- When placed on a stake or a plant stalk, traps should be wrapped around the stake or stalk.

For use in monitoring:

Apple Maggot/Walnut Husk Fly Apple Maggot Vol6 Vine Mealybug

Multigard AM Trap: Apple Maggot/Walnut Husk Fly Apple Maggot Vol6 Olive Fruit Fly



- Push the arrow-shaped tab at top and bottom of trap through the square knockouts to secure the trap in an open position.
- A wire clip can be pushed through the round holes at the top of the trap for securing to a stake.

 In corn, place trap inside a leaf whorl at ear height.
- Check traps regularly, at least twice a week.

 Record and remove captured insects.

 Replace traps when necessary.
